



## Newsletter – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter

October 2023 to December 2023



#### Educational Activities at the Veerni Institute and the Veerni Balika Centre

- **Associate School**: The Veerni girls attend Modern Senior Secondary School on a daily basis from 7:30 AM to 1:30 PM.
- Extra Tuition Classes: Veerni Institute and Veerni Balika Centre conduct extra tuition classes regularly.
- **Computer Classes**: Veerni has appointed a qualified computer teacher for computer education. Computer classes are conducted for an hour every day at the Veerni Institute and at Veerni Balika Centre.
- Online Tuition Classes: The Veerni Institute has a well-equipped smart classroom where senior Veerni girls of classes 9 to 12 receive additional help with their studies through online lectures. Online tuition is conducted regularly at the Veerni Institute.
- Second Unit Test: Second assessment started on October 9th and concluded on October 14th. All the girls participated in the unit tests and their have done in it and they have completed them.
- Half Yearly Examination: started on December 11<sup>th</sup> and concluded on December 23<sup>rd</sup>. The examinations went well; results are still awaited.

**Diwali Vacation and Reopening**: The Veerni Institute had a Diwali vacation from November 6th to November 19th. The girls went home on November 6th and were gifted sweets. After the vacation, the staff returned on November 18th, and the girls returned on November 19th, recharged with new energy and ready to embrace the upcoming academic endeavors with renewed enthusiasm.













**Winter Vacation**: Winter vacation has been announced by the school from December 23rd to January 01st. This year, only classes 6 and 7 have gone on vacation, while the remaining classes stayed at the institute to prepare for their annual examinations, which are due in February/ March 2024. The management of Modern Senior Secondary School has decided to conduct regular classes for the girls who stayed at the institute.

#### **Health Care Activities**

Veerni Institute takes the health and wellbeing of its girls seriously. The Veerni medical team, comprising Dr. A.S. Deora, Mrs. Vimlesh Sharma (nurse), and Mrs. Syiona Kalasua (volunteer), provides regular medical coverage to the girls. Each girl has a complete health card that contains all the details related to her health. Dr. Deora visits once a week, and the nurse is available on a daily basis, ensuring that the girls receive the best possible care.

In addition to medical care, Veerni Institute also provides health education lectures on a regular basis. The lectures cover a range of topics, including eye health, seasonal diseases, the use of sanitary napkins, skin diseases, a healthy diet, and other important health items.

Promoting Menstrual Health: In a commitment to menstrual health and hygiene, sanitary napkins were distributed regularly. This initiative aims to ensure the well-being and dignity of every girl at the institute.

Nutritional Support with Protein Supplements: Starting on October 6th, the Veerni Institute initiated the distribution of protein supplements. This step emphasizes the holistic well-being of the girls, providing them with essential nutrients for their physical development.









<u>Best Healthy Girl Award</u>: In October, Dr. Deora introduced the Best Healthy Girl Award, with three categories: 1) Below 13 years, 2) Above 13 years to 15 years, and 3) Above 15 years. The girls who won the awards are:

- First Prize: Ms. Anushya, age 13; Ms. Dimple Kanwar, age 14; Ms. Mamta, age 18.
- Second Prize: Ms. Vanshika, age 13; Ms. Poonam, age 14; Ms. Seema, age 18.
- Third Prize: Ms. Kratika, age 13; Ms. Sanju, age 14; Ms. Manisha, age 16.

The girls were thrilled to receive these awards, and the rest of the Veerni girls were motivated by this new initiative. Overall, all the Veerni girls are healthy and happy.













#### Following things have been distributed to the Veerni girls:

- New Shoes for Every Girl: On October 18th, Veerni Institute took a step towards comfort and confidence as each girl received brand new shoes, supporting them in their educational journey.
- · Institute's Outfits for Classes 4th to 7<sup>th</sup>: As of November 5th, girls in classes 4th to 7th received new hostel outfits, promoting a sense of unity and identity within the Veerni community.
- Warm Blankets for All: November 19th brought warmth to every girl at the Veerni Institute as new blankets were distributed, ensuring a cozy and comfortable environment during the colder months.
- · **Identity Card Distribution:** On October 20th, identity cards were distributed to all girls, providing them with a tangible symbol of belonging and recognition within the Veerni Institute.
- · Veerni team ensures the monthly well-being of each girl by providing a Hygiene Kit. Each kit includes hand sanitizer, sanitary napkins, washable masks, bathing and laundry soap, toothbrush and toothpaste, shampoo, and body lotion. This initiative reflects our commitment to maintaining a healthy and hygienic environment for our girls.














#### **Sports Activities:**


