We work tirelessly to break the cycle of gender inequality, child marriage, and lack of education by providing comprehensive support, empowerment programs, and access to essential services. Our vision is to create a society where every girl can realize her full potential and lead a life of dignity and independence.

# MISSION STATEMENT

Empowering Girls: Igniting the Flame of Strength and Courage: In Hindi, "Veerni" symbolizes a woman of remarkable fortitude and bravery. Our mission embarks on a transformative journey to educate and empower the vibrant young girls residing in these scattered villages of the Thar Desert and in the outskirts of Jodhpur, enabling them to embrace lives filled with vitality and fulfillment, free from social and economic discrimination.

The Veerni Project provides a safe and nurturing environment welcoming 110 extraordinary girls into two boarding facilities (both the Veerni Institute and Veerni Balika), where they can thrive in their pursuit of secondary education. As we strive to fulfill the United Nations' sustainable goal of universal secondary education by 2030, we acknowledge the challenging path that lies before us, yet remain resolute in our commitment to conquer this remarkable milestone.

The Veerni girls come from diverse and rural communities located in the Thar Desert. Education stands as the bedrock upon which their empowerment flourishes, granting them the ability to forge their own destinies and make life choices that resonate with their dreams. Education, in its essence, is the catalyst that propels all forms of empowerment, igniting a spark of change that permeates through every aspect of their lives.

# VISION

Veerni envisions a world where all girls, regardless of class, caste, and economic status, can exercise their basic human rights and make independent life choices. It is our belief that true democracy depends on the full participation of empowered women within their communities and that education is the most effective instrument to secure this end.

Veerni has become the sole institute in the entire city of Jodhpur providing the HPV vaccination, even before its inclusion in the National Immunization Program in India. This groundbreaking effort has significantly contributed to the girls' protection against preventable diseases.
- 9. **Local awareness raising:** Collaborating with communities to raise awareness about gender equality and the importance of education. Such as?

#### Land Purchase for Veerni Institute:

In response to the growing demand for safe accommodation for Veerni students, Veerni has taken a significant step towards addressing this pressing need with the purchase of land for the Veerni Institute. The scarcity of secure and reasonably priced housing for girls has persisted as a longstanding issue, and Veerni is committed to tackling it head on. Over the past 10 to 11 months, the Veerni team has tirelessly pursued the dream of acquiring land for the institute, exploring numerous properties in the process.



During a visit to Jodhpur, Mrs. Jacqueline de Chollet, alongside other esteemed board members of the Global Foundation for Humanity and Fondation Veerni, personally inspected potential properties for the Veerni Institute. It is with great pleasure that we announce the realization of our dreams in February 2023, as the Veerni team selected a suitable piece of land to bring the Veerni Institute to life.

Situated in a safe and easily accessible area, the chosen land is conveniently close to our existing educational institutions and close to a bus route. A mere 15–20•minute drive from our current location, the land spans an impressive area of 7,587 square meters. This size allows us to accommodate the Veerni building along with essential facilities like classrooms, a garden, sports grounds, parking, and a recreation area.

During their visit to the Veerni Project, Mrs. Jacqueline de Chollet and other esteemed members of the Global Foundation of Humanity had the opportunity to personally witness the land's potential. Their endorsement further solidified our decision, leading to the successful purchase of the land. This achievement marks a significant milestone for the Veerni Project, enabling us to plan and implement long• term programs by constructing a purpose•built facility on the acquired land.

With the purchase of this land, Veerni has taken a crucial stride towards fulfilling our mission of providing safe and long•term accommodations for the girls. The establishment of the Veerni Institute will serve as a beacon of hope, empowering young women through education and enabling them to break barriers and reach their full potential.

We are immensely grateful to the board members of the Global Foundation for Humanity, USA and Fondation Veerni, Switzerland, for their invaluable support throughout our journey. It is their unwavering commitment and unwavering belief in our cause that has transformed our dream into a tangible reality. 
#### **Education Program:**

Our education and empowerment programs focus on providing quality education, and life skills training to Veerni girls. We offer academic support, career counseling, and mentorship programs to enable girls to pursue higher education and professional aspirations.

The educational journey at Veerni spanning from the 6th to the 12th grades, includes girls from diverse castes and social groups, representing numerous villages in the region surround Jodhpur.

Providing a solid foundation for their educational pursuits, the Veerni girls attend two exceptional schools, Modern Senior Secondary School and The Saviour's Academy Secondary School.

At The Saviour's Academy Secondary School, girls attend classes and have teachers coming from the school to teach additional lessons at the Institute. For girls in classes 9 to 12, they attend Modern Senior Secondary School on a daily basis. The school provides convenient round trip transportation with two buses dedicated to Veerni students, ensuring their safe and timely arrival. Both institutions have displayed an unwavering commitment to supporting the girls, even providing transportation services to the facilities.



#### **Academic Activities**

<u>New Girls' Admission at Veerni Institute:</u> In the academic year 2022•2023, Veerni Institute received over 450 applications for just 14 vacant seats, showcasing the recognition of its invaluable opportunity. Three entrance tests were conducted to assess academic potential, followed by interviews to evaluate candidates and their parents' commitment.

From the interviews, 14 girls were granted admission. Selection is made on a case by case basis. This process exemplifies Veerni's commitment to empowering girls through education and shaping bright futures.

#### **Veerni Girls**

<u>Joining the Institute</u>: Veerni Institute commenced a new academic session on July 1st with great enthusiasm and careful planning. The dedicated staff returned early to ensure a smooth transition for the girls. A phased approach was implemented to invite the girls, with classes 6 to 8 joining on June 26th and 27th, followed by classes 9 to 12 on June 29th and 30th. This allowed for personalized attention and maintained a safe environment.

Health check•ups were conducted for each girl, prioritizing their well•being. COVID•19 testing was carried out when necessary, ensuring the safety of all students and staff.

Upon arrival, girls received hand sanitizers and new water bottles, promoting good hygiene practices and a healthy atmosphere.

On July 1st, all 110 girls embarked on their educational journey at Veerni Institute and Veerni Balika, filled with excitement and promise. The institute's commitment to holistic development, meticulous planning, and precautionary measures set the stage for a successful academic session.

With the arrival of the Veerni girls, a new chapter begins—a chapter of empowerment, growth, and endless opportunities. Veerni Institute remains dedicated to providing quality education and holistic care, shaping a brighter future for the girls and their communities.

<u>New Class Added at Veerni Institute</u>: In response to over 450 applications for just 14 seats, Veerni conducted entrance tests for admission. Encountering families affected by the pandemic, Veerni expanded its age range and admitted girls from class 3, in addition to the usual classes 6 to 12. This decision addresses the exceptional circumstances and provides educational opportunities to those in need.







## A New Initiative - English Medium Education for the Veerni Girls:

Responding to the aspirations of the Veerni girls and their parents, the Veerni team introduced an exciting new initiative this academic year. Building upon the success of Veerni's first•ever summer school program, there was a growing demand for English classes. In response, Veerni took the progressive step of offering English Medium education to the students in classes 6 to 8. This initiative not only elevates the standard of education but also fosters health competition within the Veerni Institute, directly benefiting the girls. Veerni partnered with The Saviour's Academy Secondary



School, an esteemed English medium school, and enrolled girls from classes 6 to 8. The positive feedback from both the girls and their parents reflects their happiness and appreciation for this new initiative.

## **Digital Literacy:**

Computer Classes: Computer classes are now an integral part of the curriculum at the Veerni Institute and Veerni Balika. Veerni girls receive basic training on computer components and essential skills such as typing and MS Office applications. Led by Mr. Shiv Prakash Hatila, a qualified computer teacher, theses daily one•hour classes provide supportive learning environment.



#### **Extra Tuition Classes:**

At Veerni Institute and Veerni Balika, we go the extra mile to ensure our girls excel in their studies. To provide them with additional support, we organize special tuition classes within the institute. During these sessions, our dedicated Veerni teachers offer personalized assistance, addressing any challenges the girls may face in their schoolwork. These classes serve as a valuable platform for our girls to receive guidance, clarification, and solutions to their educational queries. We believe that with the right guidance, every girl can unlock her full potential and thrive academically.

Online Tuition Classes: Keeping pace with the ever evolving digital landscape, the Veerni Institute is equipped with state of the • art smart classroom. Here, our girls have access to online lectures and educational resources, further augmenting their learning journey. Through these virtual tuition classes, our girls benefit from expert instruction and interactive learning experiences, enhancing their understanding of various subjects. The online platform not only facilitates flexible learning but also promotes technological literacy, empowering our girls with the skills they need to thrive in the digital age. We are proud to provide our girls with cutting • edge educational opportunities that broaden their horizons and ignite their passion for knowledge.







#### **Study Hours and Parents Meeting:**

At VEERNI, we ensure that the girls receive the best possible environment for their academic and personal growth. In the report below, we showcase how the study periods and parent•teacher meetings (PTMs) were conducted at the institute during this year.

- 1. Study Periods at Veerni Institute and Veerni Balika: We understand the importance of self•study for the academic progress of the students. Therefore, we have designated specific study periods for different classes at the both the centres.
  - Classes III to VIII have study periods from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm and then from 8:00 pm to 10:00 pm.
  - Classes IX and XI have study periods from 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm and then from 8:00 pm to 10:00 pm.
  - Classes X and XII have study periods from 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm, followed by an extra hour from 5:30 pm to 6:30 pm, and then from 8:00 pm to 11:00 pm.
  - We have also arranged for extra classes on Sundays for these classes. These study periods are strictly observed, and students are expected to utilize this time for selfor study.





Parents Meetings at Veerni Institute and Veerni Balika: Parents meetings are crucial for effective communication between parents and Veerni's administration. These meetings provide an opportunity for parents to get an update on their child's academic progress and to discuss any concerns they may have with the Veerni staff and the administrative staff of the Veerni Institute. The study periods and parent•teacher meetings conducted at the Veerni Institute and Veerni Balika were effective in ensuring the academic progress of the Veerni girls. The study periods provided students with the necessary time for self•study. Parents meetings take place every Sunday and ensure effective communication between parents and Veerni.

## Distribution of Essential Items to Veerni Girls:

The Veerni Project is dedicated to providing essential support to the Veerni girls, ensuring they have access to necessary resources for their education and well•being. The distribution of various items has been a significant part of this support system:

<u>School Kits</u>: Upon their arrival, the Veerni girls receive school kits comprising books, school bags, notebooks, stationery, and subject • wise study material. These kits equip them with the essential tools they need to pursue their education effectively.

<u>Hygiene Kits</u>: The Veerni Project prioritizes the girls' hygiene and well • being by distributing monthly hygiene kits to all 112 Veerni girls. These kits contain hand sanitizers, sanitary napkins, washable masks, bathing and laundry soaps, toothpaste and brush, shampoo, and body lotion. This ensures that the girls have access to vital hygiene resources, promoting their overall health and comfort.

<u>Feminine Hygiene Products</u>: The girls are provided with sanitary napkins, and appropriate arrangements are made in their rooms to ensure convenience and accessibility to these essential items.

<u>New Uniforms Distribution</u>: On October 19th, new uniforms were distributed to the girls, coinciding with their Diwali celebrations. The girls expressed their joy and gratitude upon receiving these new uniforms. Additionally, on February 3rd, 2023, new high quality uniforms were distributed to establish a standardized dress code for the Veerni girls. The uniforms, consisting of a Salwar, kurta, and waistcoat, were thoughtfully designed for both comfort and identification purposes, contributing to discipline and security within the institute.









In August 2022, Veerni introduced the Veerni girls' cabinet, embodying the essence of democracy in action. Eleven exceptional girls were chosen by their peers to serve as cabinet ministers. This unique initiative fosters a sense of responsibility, cooperation, and leadership among the girls. Each member of the Veerni Cabinet has the opportunity to experience the role of a minister, actively participating in decision• making processes and contributing tothedevelopmentofour community. Through the Veerni Cabinet, we empower our girls to embrace leadership roles, nurturing their potential to become influential agents of change.

Regular communication between parents and their children at Veerni Institute and Veerni Balika i s prioritized to strengthen their bond and provide emotional support. Every 15 days, parents are encouraged to stay connected with their children through phone calls, video chats, or other means. This ensures that parents are informed about their child's well•being, daily activities, and any challenges they may be facing, promoting a sense of connection and support.

At the crack of dawn, our Veerni girls assemble on the grounds, ready to unleash their potential and leave an indelible mark on the field.

The courage and determination displayed by our athletes are truly awe•inspiring. In recognition of their skill, perseverance, and dedication, regular prizes are awarded, celebrating their accomplishments and fueling their pursuit of greatness.

Through sports, Veerni Institute empowers Veerni girls, equipping them not only with physical prowess but also with invaluable life lessons. #### **Health Care Programs**

At Veerni Institute, we prioritize the health and wellbeing of our students above all else. To ensure their physical and emotional welfare, we have implemented a healthcare system led by qualified professionals, offering comprehensive medical services.

- <u>Dedicated Medical Team</u>: Our institute boasts a team of skilled healthcare professionals, including Dr. Deora, an experienced physician, and Nurse Vimlesh. They provide regular healthcare services to our students, ensuring personalized and attentive care. Additionally, we are fortunate to have the support of volunteer nurse Syiona, who further enhances our healthcare provisions.
- Round•the•Clock Assistance: Nurse Vimlesh is available on•site every day to provide immediate health services and address any concerns or issues. Dr. Deora conducts check•ups and follow•up care visits every Friday. We also have a well•stocked first aid box and trained Veerni Matrons for handling emergencies. Quick transportation to the hospital is facilitated by a staff member residing on the premises with access to a car. Our strong connections with hospitals, facilitated by volunteer nurse Siyona, further strengthens our healthcare network.
- Holistic Healthcare Initiatives: Proactive healthcare measures are emphasized at Veerni Institute. We conduct regular health camps and initial screenings upon the girls' arrival. Preventive care is prioritized, with essential vaccinations, including DPT, MMR, Hepatitis B, and HPV immunizations for cervical cancer prevention. Nutrition supplements are provided to support overall health, and regular distribution of sanitary napkins ensures menstrual hygiene.



The exchange of ideas, culture and knowledge between people and nations is remarkable: the global connectivity that we experience is one that would have been hard to predict at the time when I was growing up, just after the second world war. These connections exist even for those living in the most remote regions of the world including the Thar Desert in India where the Veerni project is based.

In 1993 Veerni started out as a modest, village • based project caring for women and children's health in a deeply patriarchal society. Today Veerni champions the education of girls supporting them to finish secondary school (the 4<sup>th</sup> UN Sustainable Development Goal). This change is due to the encouragement of their mothers. However, recently their fathers, have come to value the impact of education on their daughters, something previously unheard of in rural Rajasthan. Achieving gender equality fulfills the 5<sup>th</sup> UN Sustainable Goal.

#### Context

In India today the 850 million people under the age of thirty-five have the potential to significantly impact the welfare and economy of their country of 1.4 billion. India's population has now surpassed China's and is becoming the most populated country in the world. With this growth comes the potential for geopolitical, economic and cultural power.

#### **Poverty in India:**

Indians remain poor by global standards. A part of the population is left behind and has little hope of coming out of poverty. Free market economics have resulted, according to Oxfam, in 1% of the population owning more than 40% of the wealth of the country where as 50% of the population, some 700 million people, own 3% of the wealth. India is a country of the very poor.

One third of children are suffering from malnutrition. There are no means to be unemployed; as a result, the bottom half is in danger of staying at the lowest of the human condition. Escaping poverty can only be through education.

#### Women in India and economic progress:

India's potential is vast, and its economy is the fifth largest in the world. However less than half of the population contributes to the country's economy. Critically, only one in five women are in the formal work force, that is 20%, the lowest anywhere in the world. In the informal workforce it is 30%. In China, in contrast, women's participation in the work force is more than 60%.

#### Will India become a super power?

Yes "made in India" is in full boom. The country exports some 750 billion dollars per year particularly in pharmaceuticals and software.

Another important factor is that India has a massive diaspora. Of some 13 million expats, including the offspring of Indians worldwide, the number reaches 32 million which is a considerable asset. In the UK and in the US where 6 million of Indian origin live, this diaspora occupies most often high social economic positions are a powerful source of influence. The bosses of Microsoft, Google, IBM, FedEx, Starbucks, Barclays Bank, including the UK Prime Minister, Rishi Sunak.

#### The central question to ask is why are women in India still negatively valued?

The country has a long history of struggles against patriarchy. In addition, sexism, misogyny, are all implicated in India's familiar subjugation of women. In 2022 India ranked 135 out of 146 countries in the World Economic Global Forum Gender Gap Report. Importantly, female literacy rate stands at 66% against near 80% for men.

This hinders the aspirations of hundreds of millions of Indian young women as well as holding back the Indian economy.

In order for India's young population to reach its full potential, investments in education, health, nutrition and skills training for women is vitally important. The project has had a strong impact on the girls' lives, empowering them to break the cycle of discrimination and poverty.

#### **Child Brides:**

The practice remains a custom and it affects up to 40% of girls at the Veerni project, down from 60% a few years ago. Importantly, the number of child brides from the Veerni villages has seen a significant drop of the practice since the Project's presence in these villages compared with non Veerni ones. It is a key measure of the impact the project has had over the years.

#### India at a turning point:

There is now an opportunity for India to take advantage of its position and to really transform itself given its access to technology, capital and international markets. Women are a vital part of this development.

# **The Veerni Project:**

### A Drop in the Ocean• the importance of the Project

The girls that Veerni educates are but a drop in India's ocean. However, the positive transformation of attitudes to girls has come from the villagers themselves in response to a large part due to awareness• raising generated by Veerni.

### Veerni: A Holistic Approach

Many of the girls from poor rural villages have faced neglect in their families because of villager's desire for boys. They are often not seen as a priority, rather as a burden, and as a result, often neglected by their families and the community. The demand for places at the institute increases yearly. This year some 450 for 14 vacancies. Veerni girls are often selected as a result of hardship cases, such as orphans, when the mother has died, particularly in cases of COVID deaths. Despite these circumstances, they come to the Veerni Institute with a strong desire to succeed and make a better life for themselves.

A life transformed: The seven years of education from class 6•12 are transformative for these girls as, not only they are getting an education, but are exposed to a variety of programs which widens their understanding of their country and the world. In addition to their attendance to top academic schools, the Veerni program encompasses courses in computer education, sports, sewing, dance, arts and crafts, public speaking while ensuring a high level of pastoral care and nutrition.

Additionally, ensuring the safety of the girls while in the Institute is paramount both for the project and for the parents.

## Flourishing under Pressure:

The primary pressure the girls face is to succeed in their studies. Their ambition is fueled not just by desire to do well, but also because failure means the end of their dreams.

The testimony is the extremely high pass rates they achieve.

Despite this pressure, girls are thriving at the Veerni Institute. They have great achievements to their names, with many pursuing higher education and careers. The project has become a beacon of hope for girls in Rajasthan, providing them with the tools they need to succeed and make a better life for themselves and their future families. To summarize, the project has had a strong impact on the girls' lives, their future, empowering them to break the cycle of discrimination and poverty.

#### **Veerni: A nourishing environment**

The Veerni Institute provides these girls with a safe and nurturing environment where they can flourish under pressure. The girls know that if they do not succeed in their exams, their parents will remove them from the institute. This pressure is immense and is compounded by the fact that the girls have a weak educational foundation. Village schools in Rajasthan are often under•resourced, with only one teacher for all grades in a single room. As a result, the girls struggle to keep up with their studies and need additional support.

To help the girls succeed, the Veerni Institute takes a holistic approach to their development. The girls receive education, healthcare, and life skills training, preparing them for a brighter future. They are provided with individualized support and mentorship, ensuring that they have the resources they need to thrive. Additionally, the project works closely with the girls' families, educating them on the importance of girls' education and breaking down societal barriers. We call this a community outreach activity of the project.

Quote from a mother last November: "Nobody was hearing her" she continues "but because of education, her voice will be heard - she will make positive changes in her community- an educated mother would raise their children in a better way."

#### **Achievements to Date**

Since the inception of the secondary school program in 2005, 185 girls have graduated, 135 went on to higher education and some 45 girls are in the job place with this increasing yearly.

#### The Future

A permanent home for Veerni is now a priority. Until now, the Institute has been housed in rented accommodations. A secure future can only be achieved through a permanent home. Land has been purchased this year, in a safe and convenient location with a supply of fresh water and proximity to public transport. The challenge ahead is constructing the building. Future outreach programs as a center of excellence will be housed in the new building as well and will enable the project to fully serve the communities in the area.
